# Governance Project of the Year

What an amazing achievement for our National Governing Body the British Taekwondo Council as they have been shortlisted for Governance Project of the Year through the Corporate Governance Institute, and are up against some very big names.

Not only are they working to make Taekwondo a properly governed Martial Art and sport but they are also on a par with some global organisations.



Sport England who are one of the funding partners for National Governing Bodies has also put safeguarding as a top priority and require that ALL instructors and coaches complete certified safeguarding training, it is a stipulation they have specified to the BTC. This is not an optional requirement but an obligatory one which all National Governing Bodies must implement to maintain their National Governing Body status and funding, also to prove they have implemented it



#### What does this mean for you?

What it means is that ALL of the BTC instructors must have completed a basic safeguarding course within the last 3 years, you can check when you did one or it expires on your instructor listing on the BTC website. Additionally there is a further requirement that ALL instructors complete a Safeguarding Adults In Sport Framework online course. There are a number of online safeguarding courses you can do on the NSPCC and the Ann Craft Trust websites, they do have a small charge to undertake them . If you do take the courses please could you send copies of your certificates to the UKTDC Secretary who will then pass them on to the BTC.



# Safeguarding a top priority


Many public and funded organisations are putting safeguarding as one of their most top priorities, requiring their staff members who come into contact with both adults and children to undertake safeguarding training. Following high profile scandals such as the alleged abuse of British Gymnastics athletes it is essential that all coaches and instructors have the appropriate level of training to spot and prevent any form of abuse or discrimination allbeit physical or emotional.

### Restructuring





Another requirement of the BTC to maintain their funding is that they restructure to a more modern business model which helps protect the funding path, ensure impartiality and that they are fit for purpose in an evolving landscape.

As part of the restructuring there is to be a change in the hierarchical structure of a board of directors and an executive committee which will include senior members and independent directors. The current BTC board will bring the restructuring into place and will then hand over to the new board of directors.

4 member organisations were eligible to apply for directorship and the UKTDC was one of them, as such UKTDC Secretary General Christopher Davies has submitted an application to become one of the new directors. There will follow a vetting process by Sport England and the BTC including an interview after which a decison will be made.

This kind of setup is a requirement for all UK governing bodies meaning that many of them are currently going through a similar process.

### Temporary Insurance



Going on holiday?

Temporary holiday insurance for an assistant instructor?

Something that has come up at the BTC meetings is what insurance cover is availanble when an instructor goes on holiday and an assistant instructor takes over the class. The BTC has managed to get a deal with the insurance company that should deal with this issue.

For a year the Insurance company has agreed to give non charge-able cover for up to 4 weeks to an assistant instructor on the condition that they are 18 or over, hold a certified black belt and have DBS clearance. To get this insurance the instructor will need to complete a form on the BTC website and submit it to the BTC prior to the instructor going on holiday.
